- Stage I. 1 4 weeks remotely in UNDP Partnership Support Office (Russia, Moscow) and
- Stage II. 12 16 weeks in one of the UNDP country offices in Armenia, Belarus, Kyrgyzstan, Serbia, Tajikistan or Uzbekistan or Istanbul Regional Hub (Turkey, Istanbul)

Minimum qualifications required:

√ Russian citizenship;

✓ Enrollment in Master's or equivalent programme in the field of international relations, economics, trade development, local/regional development, communications, management, social sciences, environmental sciences, climate, energy, disaster risk management, legal studies, gender studies, or other relevant fields;

Recent Master's graduates (less than 1 year after graduation) can also be considered.

- ✓ Written and spoken proficiency in English and Russian;
- ✓ Proficiency in MS Office (MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.), Adobe, Photoshop/Illustrator skills are a plus;
- ✓ Work and volunteer experience in the fields above and the thematic areas below is highly desirable.

Thematic areas for internships:

- Sustainable and inclusive economic growth,
- o International trade facilitation,
- Rule of law and governance,
- Gender equality,
- Youth and women empowerment,
