

History and Methodology of Management (Philosophy)

Full name of the professor: research scientist, PhD in Philosophy Rogozhnikova Varvara Nikolaevna.

Place of the course in the Master's programme: foundation part, 1 trimester.

Brief content of the course: subject and object of management, place of management discipline in the structure of economic science, the relationship between management and other sciences, general problems of management (including methodological problems), management strategies, the history of managerial thought, ethical problems of management; definition of a method and methodology, levels and methods of scientific knowledge.

This discipline is devoted to the philosophical and methodological foundations of management. During the course, students analyze and evaluate philosophical problems while solving social and professional problems, highlight the main trends in the development of administrative science and practice, prepare analytical materials on managing business processes and assessing their effectiveness, summarize and critically evaluate the results obtained by domestic and foreign researchers, get acquainted with the general concepts of the development of science, philosophical and methodological problems and the fundamentals of management, the basics of interdisciplinary research in management, various methodological strategies in management. The main method of studying the discipline is analysis and dialectical method.

Workload of the discipline is 2 ECTS, 72 hours.

Language of instruction: English.

Course midterm control is conducted in the form of final written examination.
