

International Commercial Law

Full name of the professor: Motovilova D.A.

Place of the course in the Master's programme: elective course of the master program, 2 trimester.

Brief content of the course: Main elements of legal systems; Law of obligations; Law of obligations; Intellectual Property Law; Competition Law; Consumer Protection Law; Labor law; Personal data protection legislation.

As part of the discipline, students get acquainted with the classification of law, main legal systems, sources and characteristics of general and civil law; the nature of agreement, essential elements of contracts, types of contractual terms, factors affecting the validity of contracts; corporate credentials and management. Particular attention is paid to intellectual property law and competition law, as well as legal standards in the field of consumer protection, fair and unfair commercial practices. The discipline also forms an understanding of the key issues of labor law, the basic principles of personal data protection and legislation in this area.

Workload of the discipline is 3 ECTS, 108 hours.

Language of instruction: English.

Course midterm control is conducted in the form of written examination.
