

Global trends in corporate governance

Full name of the professor: Gerald Rohan.

Place of the course in the Master's programme: elective course, 3 trimester.

Brief content of the course: History of Corporate Governance; The relationship between concepts of Self-Regulations, Event driven regulation; Agency theory, the role and duties of the Board of Directors; The Responsibility to the Shareholders and Stakeholders; Corporate Governance Regulations in selected jurisdictions; Corporate Governance in Russian listed companies.

Discipline gives an idea of the basics and origins of corporate governance in modern business history. Particular attention is paid to current trends in corporate governance, which affect both international companies operating in different jurisdictions and companies operating only under Russian law. The main topic of study of the discipline is the identification of corporate governance value.

Workload of the discipline is 3 ECTS, 108 hours.

Language of instruction: English.

Course midterm control is conducted in the form of final projects presentation.
