

Entrepreneurial Growth

Full name of the professor: associate prof. Karin Hellerstedt.

Place of the course in the Master's programme: elective course, 4 trimester.

Brief content of the course: Concept of Entrepreneurial Growth; Components of entrepreneurial growth; Structures for entrepreneurial growth.

The purpose of the discipline is to familiarize students with the concept of entrepreneurial growth. Students will gain knowledge on how to grow a business, what resources are needed for this, what growth strategies exist, and how to identify difficulties and overcome them in the process of entrepreneurial growth. Upon completion of this course, students will be able to: (1) understand and explain growth processes in startups and existing firms; (2) identify suitable growth patterns; (3) critically evaluate the knowledge gained and adapt it to an empirical context; as well as improve communication and information processing skills

Workload of the discipline is 6 ECTS, 216 hours.

Language of instruction: English.

Course midterm control is conducted in the form of course projects presentation.
