

Advanced Leadership

Full name of the professor: assistant professor Daniel Pittino.

Place of the course in the Master's programme: elective course, 4 trimester.

Brief content of the course: Strategic leadership; Global leadership skills; Fostering professional and responsible leadership: the role of gender, ethics, communication and identity.

The discipline is built on a set of theoretical leadership views that cover key topics such as strategic leadership / change, global leadership skills, power, crisis management, gender, ethics, communication and identity that foster professional and responsible leadership. Upon completion of the study of this discipline, students will be able to: (1) conduct a detailed analysis of specific situations from the perspective of various leadership theories, critically evaluate leadership examples; (2) understand and explain the relationship of emotional dynamics and the process of developing a strategy; (3) critically evaluate leadership models both from the point of view of efficiency and from the point of view of the leader's values, his vision and moral and ethical principles. Discipline will also allow students to improve personal leadership and communication skills.

Workload of the discipline is 6 ECTS, 216 hours.

Language of instruction: English.

Course midterm control is conducted in the form of group projects presentation.
